


2022 SEASAT Youth Camp

About

The goal of SEASAT Youth Camp is to enrich 30-40 young people, ages 18 to 24, in their familiarity with their ASEAN, South Asian, and Taiwan neighbors with the hopes of promoting better understanding and cooperation among international youth. In collaboration with the American Institute in Taiwan, the three-day session will expose participants to lectures on contemporary issues affecting the region, cultural and educational tours, seminars, and a crash course on social innovation. The Camp will also double as a networking platform to further connect SEASAT Youth.

Theme

Organized by the American Institute in Taiwan and the Taiwan-Asia Exchange Foundation, the 2022 SEASAT Youth Camp aims to bring together young representatives in Taiwan to investigate how to enhance youth engagement in Asian democracies, explore ways in which the younger generation has responded to urgent issues both locally and globally through innovative projects, and design their own practical agendas in achieving a more democratic and livable future where social discrimination is diminished, economic inequality reduced, and youth voices heard.

From the Milk Tea Alliance to Myanmar's civil disobedience movement, to feminist and LGBTQ advocacy, we have witnessed that youth have been instrumental in initiating and sustaining social transformation across Asia. In addition, more youth are become actively engaged in politics, ensuring better institutional transition. While student and youth activism has separate historical roots and trajectories in Asia, their methods of critical engagement and coalition politics have significantly changed in response to recent developments in digital technology, international challenges, and the changing nature of democracy.

With the pandemic having exacerbated structural disparity, political turmoil, and unequal distribution of resources across the globe, this year's Youth Camp will foster social bonding, social innovation, and social solutions during a time of social distancing. Although these emerging ideas might grow from specific Asian contexts, we believe that these conversations and practices could yield significant implications for our global partners, especially those who have suffered from the Russo-Ukrainian War, humanitarian crises, and severe deprivation of basic human needs.

Topic

The 2022 Youth Camp identifies nine core elements that constitute the future of Asian democracies, namely "digital," "education," "migrants," "ocean," "culture," "resilience," "activism," "communication," and "youth"— with the initial letters of these keywords constitute spelling democracy:

- Digital governance in the new Indo-Pacific order
- Educational reforms for the future of work
- Migrants' participation and integration for future democracy
- Reframing maritime cooperation across Indo-Pacific oceans
- Culture as the driving force in regional revitalization
- Building city resilience and achieving SDGs
- Youth in action for gender equality and social justice
- New media communication and new ways of storytelling
- Fostering different futures for youth in Asia

Activity

Through the classroom and on-site activities during the daytime and nightly group work with peers, we hope that participants will reaffirm their sense of duty towards their communities, countries, and region.

Fee

Organizers will cover all local expenses incurred during the camp, including meals, lodging (two beds per room), insurance, educational materials, and other miscellaneous fees (museum or other entrance fees), and local transportation for event-related activities.

NOTE: Organizers will not provide subsidies or sponsorships for transportation and visas. Participants are encouraged to find external funding for their own round-trip transportation to Taipei, Taiwan.

Obligation

Successful applications will be invited to attend the 2022 SEASAT Youth Camp, and are obliged to:

- attend all lectures and activities
- submit a 1500-word essay—either in English or Chinese—on one of the topics covered in the Youth Camp before August 31, 2022.

Outstanding essays with insightful arguments and elegant writing style will be published in TAEF's media outlets and other international media.

Selection

As there are limited slots, applications will be screened by a selection committee. Successful applicants will be notified on 22 June 2022 at 17:00 (GMT+8 Taipei Time).

IMPORTANT: Please be advised to wait for selection results before booking your transportation. Only successful applicants will be accommodated in the activities during the camp.
