

# Table of Contents & Section Summaries

## 01 Food & Dining

- **CSMU Apex Food Court:**

Located on the 1st floor of Cheng-Ai Building, offering a variety of bento boxes, noodles, fast food, and beverages; discounts are available for students and staff presenting their ID cards.

- **Daqing Night Market:**

Open every Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday (17:00–00:00); located within an 8–10 minute walk from campus, offering local snacks and international street foods.

- **Jianguo North Twilight Market:**

Open daily from 14:30 to 19:30, featuring fresh fruits, cooked foods, and local snacks—an ideal spot for grocery shopping or dinner.

- **Daqing Street Commercial District:**

Extending from the main and side entrances of the university, serving as an off-campus food area packed with affordable local eateries, brunch spots, and drink shops.

- **Gongxue Road Commercial District:**

A 5-minute scooter ride from campus, featuring numerous restaurants, drugstores, and supermarkets.

- **Amart Food Court (Fuxing Branch):**

Located inside Amart Fuxing Store; offers a spacious, air-conditioned environment, making it a great dining alternative on rainy days.

## 02 Clothing & Style

- **NET:**

A local Taiwanese fashion brand offering casual wear as well as formal suits and dress shirts suitable for job interviews.

- **UNIQLO / GU:**

Japanese fast-fashion retailers providing versatile basics (such as HEATTECH thermals) and trendy everyday apparel.

- **Yizhong Street Commercial District:**

A hub for budget-friendly student fashion, Korean-style womenswear, vintage clothing, and footwear.

- **Calligraphy Greenway & Park Lane Area:**

A vibrant district with a refined, artistic atmosphere, featuring independent boutiques and handmade accessory shops hidden in nearby alleyways.

- **Fengjia Commercial District:**

A major shopping spot for affordable clothing and trendy shoes, known for rapid trend updates.

- **Department Stores & Outlets:**

Includes Chungyo Department Store, Shin Kong Mitsukoshi, Top City (Far Eastern), and Mitsui Outlet Park for brand-name shopping.

## 03 Housing & Living

- **Oral Medicine Building Dormitory (Female Dorm):**

Located on the main campus, a 1–3 minute walk to academic buildings; offers double and triple suite rooms (restricted to first-year students).

- **Daqing Dormitory (Male/Female Dorm):**

Located on Gaogong Road near Taichung Municipal Taichung Industrial High School; features apartment-style shared units (3–4 residents per unit).

- **Off-Campus Rental Options:**

Key rental areas include Daqing Street Section 2, Gongxue/Gaogong Road, and Fuxing Road Section 1; includes guides for online rental platforms, Facebook housing groups, 591 Housing, and a move-in checklist.

## 04 Transportation

- **City Bus:**

Multiple bus stops near the campus gate and surrounding streets; major routes include 73, 58, 159, Green 1, and Green 3.

- **YouBike:**

At least 7 YouBike 2.0 stations are located around the campus for easy short-distance commutes.

- **MRT:**

Close to MRT Daqing Station, providing direct access to Taichung HSR Station, Vieshow Cinemas (Wenxin Branch), and Taichung City Hall.

- **TRA Train:**

TRA Daqing Station is an elevated train station connecting to local trains across Taiwan or to Taichung Main Station.

- **High-Speed Rail (HSR):**

Taichung HSR Station (Wuri) is approximately 10 minutes away by train from Daqing Station.

- **Ride-Hailing & Taxis:**

Licensed ride-hailing platforms include LINE GO, Uber, Taiwan Taxi (55688), and yoxi.

## 05 Education & Academics

- **National Library of Public Information (NLPI):**

One of Taiwan's top public libraries, offering extensive collections, study spaces, and online seat reservation systems.

- **Digital Learning & Online Resources:**

School-authorized e-journals and databases, along with access to platforms like Coursera, Hahow, and NTU OpenCourseWare.

- **On-Campus Libraries & Study Centers:**

Zheng-Xin Building (1F/6F/10F/12F learning corners and group study rooms) and Cheng-Ai Building 11F (quiet study room for national exams).

- **Group Discussion & Presentation Spaces:**

Multi-functional IT areas and study corners located in Zheng-Xin Building.

- **Study-Friendly Cafes:**

Coffee shops with no time limits such as Louisa Coffee, Cama, and local independent vintage cafes.

- **Independent Bookstores & Cultural Spaces:**

Central Bookstore, Jasmine Secondhand Books, Ruicheng Bookstore, and A-Bookstore.

## 06 Leisure & Recreation

- **Calligraphy Greenway & PARK2:**

PARK2 Caowu Square, weekend indie art markets, and open lawns perfect for picnics.

- **National Taichung Theater & Phase 7 District:**

Iconic architecture designed by Toyo Ito, featuring a rooftop garden and night views.

- **National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts & Shen Ji New Village:**

Contemporary art exhibitions at NTMoFA and renovated historic village studios with craft sweets.

- **Gaomei Wetlands & Taichung Port Area:**

Famous for mirror-like boardwalk sunsets, wind turbines, and the oceanfront Ferris wheel at Mitsui Outlet.

- **Green Air Corridor & Old Town Walk:**

An elevated linear park built along former railway tracks connecting Miyahara Eye Hospital and Imperial Sugar Factory.

- **Parks & Outdoor Spaces:**

Feng-Le Sculpture Park and Wen-Xin Forest Park.
